🍷🍷🍷🍷 **Remus Old Vine Eden Valley Shiraz 2013** From low-yielding 50+yo vines, open-fermented, some whole bunches, in predominantly new French hogsheads for 22 months. The low yield and vinification haven't led to dead fruit and/or over-extraction; this wine has exceptional intensity and power, the whole-bunch inclusion providing some lift, the French oak a flavour counterbalance for a wine of the highest quality. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 97 **To** 2053 **\$70** ⬤

🍷🍷🍷🍷 **Zephyrus Shiraz 2014** 61% Barossa Valley, 39% Eden Valley. A beautifully wrought and detailed palate, so supple it literally glides through to the finish and aftertaste without even a momentary pause for thought. Will live for decades, but can also be consumed tonight. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 96 **To** 2038 **\$45** ⬤

Romulus Old Vine Barossa Valley Shiraz 2013 From three low-yielding vineyards, matured in mainly new American hogsheads for 20 months. The come-hither message of the bouquet leads into an even more seductive palate with folds of velvet and satin around dark cherry and plum fruit, soft tannins a constant undertow. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 96 **To** 2038 **\$70** ⬤

Freya Eden Valley Riesling 2015 Still crystal white; a floral blossom bouquet; intensely focused and equally long on the palate and aftertaste; lime zest and juice have an electrifying acidity, marking the quality of the wine now and into the future. Screwcap. 12.5% alc. **Rating** 95 **To** 2035 **\$27** ⬤

Marschall Barossa Shiraz 2014 Matured for 18 months in new and used oak. Deep crimson-purple; a layered, complex and utterly coherent wine, fruit, oak and tannins waltzing across the palate. A Barossa Valley wine in Eden Valley drag. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 95 **To** 2039 **\$31** ⬤

Kennedy Barossa Valley Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre 2014 55/35/10%, vines 17–100yo, all components fermented and matured separately. The relatively deep colour tells you this is not your average Barossa GSM, the bouquet and palate shout agreement from the rooftops. This is a very high quality blend worthy of comparison to Chateau Rayas of the Rhône Valley (albeit without challenging the incomparable Rayas). Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 95 **To** 2029 **\$31** ⬤

Eurus Eden Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2013 The skilled winemaking, and very good fruit, doesn't miss a beat. Blackcurrant, bay leaf and cedary oak are moulded together with the cement provided by fine tannins that are often part of cabernet. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. **Rating** 94 **To** 2038 **\$65**
