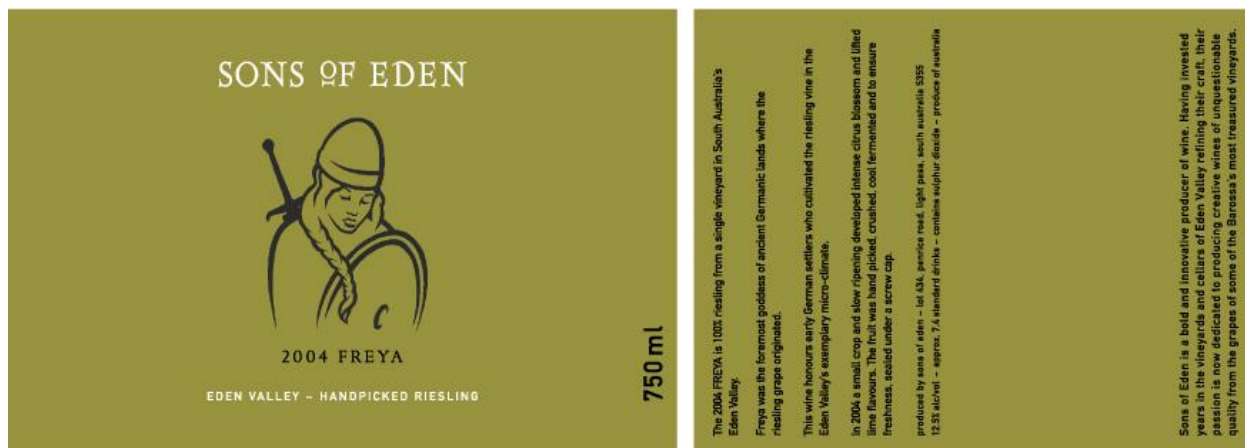


2004 Sons of Eden 'Freya' Eden Valley Riesling



Freya was the foremost goddess of ancient Germanic lands where the Riesling grape originated. This single vineyard wine honours early German settlers who cultivated the Riesling vine in the exemplary micro-climate of South Australia's Eden Valley.

The 2004 Freya Riesling has received very little winemaking intervention. It has been our intension to make an interesting and intriguing Eden Valley Riesling style, by allowing only the purest of the free run juice to experience a very long and slow fermentation thus savouring all the delicate aromas. To craft a wine with uniqueness and interest we decided to mature the wine on its yeast lees with the occasional stirring and put approximately 15% of the wine through malo-lactic fermentation.

This wine has been hand crafted to display all of the hallmark perfumed citrus lime and lemon Eden Valley Riesling aroma's. It also has a complexing and captivating silky textured mid palate, finishing with the crispness expected from a well made Riesling.
