French Puncheon barrels for 12
months unhindered maturation.
Bottled without finings and
filtration.

Montepulciano a native grape variety to the Adriatic Coast of Italy, and now grown in Eden Valley. 'Monte' is Italian for Mountain, and the high country of Eden Valley is ideally suited to growing this variety. Hiding behind the ruby coloured 'wine-tears' is the 'hidden beauty' and paradox of Montepulciano which is both sensual, mysterious and earthy in character, but at the same time liberated, wild and audacious.
